



DINOSAURS alive!

Can you tell me more about the exhibition?

Dinosaurs Alive! features seven life-like robotic dinosaurs. They look, sound and move realistically.

The largest robot is Apatosaurus (9m long).

There are information panels about the dinosaurs on display and related topic such as Climate Change, Australian dinosaurs, fossils, endangered species. There are 'fun facts' around the exhibition, which are easy for children to read.

There are also loads of fun interactives and activities for the kids to enjoy - uncover fossils in the dig-a-fossil pits, use our dinosaur stamps, piece together large dinosaur puzzles and compare your step and footprint size to that of a dinosaur! There's also a shop with books, toys and a range of useful and educative dinosaur related products.

Is it suitable for my child?

It's very difficult to gauge childrens' individual response to the dinosaurs. Age cannot determine whether they will be frightened or not, it really comes down to their personalities. Our friendly staff are available to assist should your child become frightened.

Will a guide take us around the exhibition?

No, Dinosaurs Alive! is non-facilitated exhibition.

How long does it take to view the exhibition?

The best way to get the best out of the exhibition is to take time to appreciate the dinosaurs' movements and read the information materials available. When visitors do that, they normally take between 45 to 60 minutes to view the entire exhibition. However, there is no time limit.

How Do I Buy Tickets?

You can buy two types of tickets to gain entry to the Dinosaurs Alive! exhibition:

1. Luna Park's Lunasaurus ticket which includes entry to Dinosaurs Alive! and Luna Park rides OR
2. Dinosaurs Alive! only tickets.

Is there a difference in ticket prices between on-line and door sales?

Dinosaurs Alive! tickets are the same price when you buy online or at the door, however online sales attract booking fees.

Lunasaurus passes are cheaper when you purchase them online.

Dinosaurs Alive! only entry tickets:

Adult \$18

Concession \$16

Unwaged, seniors, health care card, full time students 15 years and over.

Child \$13

5 years to 14 years old.

Children 3 to 4 years old \$8

Children under 3 years free

Family \$55

2 Adults + 2 Children or 1 Adult and 4 Children.

Additional children at \$10 each with family ticket (up to 3 additional)
